February tidbits

When your amaryllis stops blooming cut the flower stem to near the base of the plant. Start fertilizing lightly at first as the bulb needs nutrients after flower production.

Cyclamen are wonderful houseplants during the winter. They like cool temps and moist soil but don't overwater.

Start cleaning pots that you'll use later (1 part bleach to 9 parts water).

Catalogs - Browse and order seeds early. Carefully read and research when to start seeds as this varies greatly. Don't buy discounted seeds or from chain stores; germination quality isn't the best. Even good seeds don't always have 100% germination.
